59th Course on Palladian Architecture

"THAT OUTDATED WAY OF BUILDING WITHOUT ANY GRACE OR BEAUTY WHATSOEVER": PALLADIO AND THE ARCHITECTURE OF HIS RECENT PREDECESSORS

26 - 31 August 2017

Since 1958 this course has provided the opportunity to visit the principal Palladian buildings. The 2017 edition will also take a look at the often conflicted relationship between Palladio and Mediaeval architecture, especially that of the fifteenth century. The course lasting six days is divided into visits, lectures and workshops. The visits are organized as seminars in the featured buildings, with the aid of dossiers that illustrate the Palladian project drawings, plans, sections of buildings and models.



Lectures held in the lecture hall deal with general themes of Palladio's work. In the Palladio Labs (workshops), participants are involved in a hands-on approach to various modes of enquiry: How do you read a building starting from its masonry? What can the direct examination of a Palladian autograph drawing tell us? The course is addressed to architectural historians, architects, engineers, and art historians interested in exploring the works of Palladio and their physical condition.

For those who register before 15 June the enrolment fee is 550 euro + 22% VAT. After 15 June the cost is 600 euros + 22% VAT. **The application deadline is 16 August**. The enrolment fee includes the cost of group transport during the course and tickets to monuments and sites visited. The enrolment fee does not cover initial travel to Vicenza or board and lodgings. Grants are available for scholars who have attained a master's degree or specialisation since the academic year of 2007 (included) and are under forty by the date on which the course begins.
